1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the rules of PHRF SoCal Rules and By-Laws, the rules of the competing classes (except as any of these are altered by these sailing instructions), and by the USCG Navigation Rules Inland.
- 1.2. No vessel has the right of way over a large ship in the channel. RRS 60.2 and 63.1 are modified so that the Race Committee (RC) may disqualify a yacht infringing this instruction without a hearing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Entries are limited to single-hulled boats 20 feet or more in length overall (LOA) and multi-hulled vessels.
- 2.2. Boats should have a current Rating Certificate from [PHRF Southern California](#) or have a rating in the [PHRF Southern California Manufacturer List](#). All other racers must contact the Regatta Chair, listed below, for a rating.
- 2.3. To complete entry, yachts must have registered on Regatta Network at www.nycsd.club/quicker-tarrantino and have paid the entry fee of \$25 no later than 1800 Saturday, 28 March 2026.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. Sailing Instructions will be made available on the [NYCSD Regatta Network event page](#) by 1800 Saturday, 28 March 2026.
- 3.2. Notices to competitors will be posted on the front window of the NYCSD clubhouse. Any notice will also be posted on the [NYCSD Regatta Network event page](#).

4. RACE SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Racing will take place on Saturday, 04 April 2026.
- 4.2. 3 races are scheduled for all classes.
- 4.3. The scheduled warning for the first race will be 1155.

5. VENUE

- 5.1. Racing shall take place on windward/leeward courses in San Diego South Bay.
- 5.2. The Start and finish area will normally be in the vicinity of San Diego channel buoy 30.

6. CLASSES AND CLASS PENNANTS

- 6.1. The regatta is open to Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Fiddler's Cove's Capri 16.5 fleet One Design, and Multi-hull boats.
- 6.2. One Design class for the Fiddler's Cove Capri 16.5 fleet may be considered if requested by the Fleet Captain, provided that at least four boats are registered by Thursday, 26 March 2026

Class 2	Random Leg Rating of -9 through +57, with a performance factor of ≥ 4.0 based on the calculated OWC PF using ISP and the greater of either BPL or SPL.	Pennant Two
Class 3	Random Leg Rating of +58 through +89 with a performance factor < 4.0 based on the calculated OWC PF using ISP and the greater of either BPL or SPL.	Pennant Three
Class 4	Random Leg Rating of +90 through +137	Pennant Four
Class 5	Random Leg Rating of +138 or greater	Pennant Five
Class 6	Random Leg Ratings of less than +177 (non spinnaker)	Pennant Six
Class 7	Random Leg Rating of +178 and greater (non spinnaker)	Pennant Seven
Class 8	Multi-Hull	Pennant Eight
Class 9	One Design Fiddler's Cove-Capri 16.5	Pennant Nine

6.4 (DP) Competitors' pennants will be displayed from the yacht's backstay. Boats without a backstay shall display their pennants in the next most visible position.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.2 Each boat's score shall be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.
- 7.3 Ratings used to score this regatta will be the PHRF SoCal ratings as determined and supplied by PHRF SoCal.
- 7.4 PHRF non-spinnaker offsets will NOT be used for scoring.

9. CLEAN REGATTA

9.1 This regatta is a Sailors for the Sea "Clean Regatta". As such, all competitors are encouraged to use non-single use water bottles and recycle all appropriate items. Competitors are reminded of RRS 47, which states that competitors "shall not intentionally put trash in the water". Temporary bow numbers shall not be used.
