NOTICE OF RACE

Revised 1/22/2026

1. RULES

The Wednesday Night Series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), and by MYC Wednesday Night Series Sailing Instructions. Where conflicts occur among the rules, the Wednesday Night Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

The series is open to boats with a current valid 2026 PHRF-NE certificate or boats with a Portsmouth Rating.

The competing yacht shall be considered the contestant.

Eligible boats can register at Regatta Network by completing the official entry form. Each entry must be accompanied by the required entry fee to be considered valid.

Please note: that participants are required to fill out a separate entry form for each series they wish to enter. Additionally, payment must be made individually for each series. Multiple series entries cannot be combined into a single form or payment.

All entrants must complete the registration process no later than the start of the first race they intend to enter. Races will only be counted for those who have registered and paid all applicable fees in full. Participation and scoring in any race are contingent upon meeting these requirements.

Please note that a boat receiving its PHRF-NE certificate through MYC, will already be on file.

Fees for each monthly series are \$65 for MYC Members and \$100 for Non-Members.

All Skippers are to provide a cell number to be used by the Race Committee to notify them by text of any evening cancellations or any other relevant changes for that evening's races.

3. SCHEDULE of RACING

The Warning Signal for the first Class for each race is scheduled for 1800hrs

- June Series- June 3rd, June 10th, June 17th, June 24th, July 1st
- July Series- July 8th, July 15th, July 22nd, Jul 29th.
- August Series- Aug 5th, Aug 12th, Aug 19th, Aug 26th.

4. MEASUREMENTS

Each PHRF boat shall produce a valid 2026 certificate. Portsmouth Number. Rated boats will use the current Portsmouth Number Rating.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available to all competitors on the MYC website before the first race.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

Taking a One or Two- Turn Penalty in compliance with 44.1 & 44.2

7. SCORING

- Month series
 - a) Will be scored using the Low Point System (RRS A4)
 - b) When 3 or less races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scored
 - c) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst score.
- The Summer Series
 - a) Will be the total of all races in June, July, and August series.
 - b) When 8 or less races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored.
 - c) When 9 races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst race.
 - d) When 10 or more races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her races scored excluding her two worst races.

8. PRIZES:

The top three finishing competitors for each night's racing will receive an award.

The top three finishing competitors of each month's series will receive awards at the MYC Annual Meeting.

The top finisher in the Summer Series will receive an award at the MYC Annual Meeting.
