



## **MATTAPOISETT YACHT CLUB 2026 Tuesday Night Series**



### **Notice of Race Revised January 22, 2026**

#### **1. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY**

- 1.1. The competing yacht shall be considered the contestant.
- 1.2. Each competing Ensign's owner, or skipper, must be a paid-up member of the Ensign Class Association.
- 1.3. Eligible boats can register at Regatta Network by completing the official entry form. Each entry must be accompanied by the required entry fee to be considered valid.  
  
Please note: that participants are required to fill out a separate entry form for each series they wish to enter. Additionally, payment must be made individually for each series. Multiple series entries cannot be combined into a single form or payment.
- 1.4. All entrants must complete the registration process no later than the start of the first race they intend to enter. Races will only be counted for those who have registered and paid all applicable fees in full. Participation and scoring in any race are contingent upon meeting these requirements.
- 1.5. Fees for each monthly series are \$65 for MYC Members and \$100 for Non-Members.
- 1.6. All Skippers are to provide a cell number to be used by the Race Committee to notify them by text of any evening cancellations or any other relevant changes for that evening's races.

#### **2. BOATS AND SAILS:**

- 2.1. All vessels must conform to their Class Association Rules.

### **3. RACES AND RULES –Monthly Series:**

- 3.1. The series will be sailed under the 2025-2028 US Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing, each vessel's Class Association Rules, and the Mattapoisett Yacht Club Ensign Series Sailing Instructions. Where conflicts occur among the rules, the MYC Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.
- 3.2. One throw-out will be allowed if at least six races are completed. Two throw outs, if eight or more races are completed.
- 3.3. Five completed races will constitute a series.

### **4. RACES AND RULES – Summer Series:**

- 4.1. Scored as the total of all races in the June, July, and August Series.
- 4.2. Twelve races will constitute a series
- 4.3. Four throw outs will be allowed

### **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be made available to all competitors on the MYC website before the first race.

### **7. PRIZES:**

- 7.1 The top three finishing competitors for each night's racing will receive an award.
- 7.2 The top three finishing competitors of each month's series will receive awards at the MYC Annual Meeting.
- 7.3 The top finisher in the Summer Series will receive an award at the MYC Annual Meeting.
