Notice of Race June 20-21, 2026**

Venue: Huntington Lake is east of Fresno, CA in the beautiful Sierra Nevada mountains.

Organizing Authority: Hobie Division 3, HCANA and Fresno Yacht Club

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

Sailing Instructions: will be posted on the official Notice Board and on Regatta Network.

Communication: The official Notice Board is at the Race Committee tent in the beach area. Texts and emails may also be used. All boats are strongly encouraged to carry a hand-held VHF radio on board to receive communication from the race committee and to communicate in emergency situations. Channel will be stated in the Sailing Instructions.

Courses: will be defined in the Sailing Instructions and posted on the official Notice Board.

Classes: Hobie 16 A & B; Hobie 18; Hobie 20; Hobie Wave; Moore; Weta; Open

Eligibility: At least one crew of the team must be a current member of the Hobie Cat Association of North America. Hobie Cat membership register [here](#). Fee is \$55/year
