


**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current version of The Racing Rules of Sailing (2025-2028)
- 1.2 NAVAL and CRUISE SHIP PROTECTION ZONE: The Naval and Cruise Ship Protection Zone is a 500 yard regulated area of water surrounding all US Naval and Cruise Ship Vessels. All vessels within 500 yards of such vessel shall operate at the minimum speed necessary to maintain safe course and speed and shall proceed as directed by an official patrol. No vessel is allowed within 100 yards of Naval and Cruise Ship traffic.
- 1.3 All boats will carry an operational VHF radio (RC will monitor and announce on Channel 67).

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising is at the discretion of the Organizing Authority (Coronado Yacht Club).

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Hansa 303, Hansa Liberty, Martin 16 and Capri 22 classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering on Regatta Network:

- 3.3 All entries must be submitted by April 17, 2026.
- 3.4 Late entries are on a case-by-case basis.

#### **4 CLASSIFICATION**

4.1 Classes for registered boats will be explained in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **5 FEES**

5.1 Regatta entry fee is \$150.  
5.2 Late Fee of \$25 will be charged starting April 18, 2026.

#### **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 The sailing instructions will be posted on regatta network and available at the CYC Club Front Desk prior to April 24, 2026.

#### **7 VENUE**

7.1 Racing will take place on Glorietta Bay and South San Diego Bay.

#### **8 THE COURSES**

8.1 Courses will be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **9 SCHEDULE OF RACING**

9.1 The regatta will consist of ten races with one throw out after seven completed races. Three races will constitute a regatta.  
9.2 Racing Schedule  
Friday, April 24 check in & practice day.  
Saturday, April 25, first start @ 12:00 p.m.  
Sunday, April 26, first start @ 12:00 p.m.

#### **10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. CYC will be available on Channel 67.

#### **11 PRIZES**

11.1 Trophies will be awarded by class for each of the top finishers at the conclusion of racing on April 26, 2026.  
  
12.1 The celebratory dinner will be held at The Veterans of Foreign Wars of the U.S. (VFW) at 557 Orange Ave, Coronado, CA 92118 on Saturday, April 25, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m.

#### **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

13.1 Competitors participated in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks.
