Notice of Race

Event Date: Sunday, May 31, 2026

1 Rules

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), this NOR, and the SSC Standing Sailing Instructions. If there is a discrepancy between this NOR and the SSC Standing Sailing Instructions, the NOR shall govern.

2 Eligibility

- 2.1 All past and present SSC Spring Series fleet champion skippers are invited to the Race of Champions.
- 2.2 In the event you no longer have the yacht that you won your fleet with, you may sail another yacht.
- 2.3 All yachts must meet the Northern California PHRF minimum requirements, and have a NC PHRF, or Stockton Sailing Club PHRF rating. In the event that identical boats rate differently under the two rating systems, the Stockton Sailing Club ratings will apply.

3 Entries

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$10.
- 3.2 Register online on the Regatta Network event site by 9:00pm on Saturday, May 30th: [Regatta Network - 2026 SSC Race of Champions](#)
- 3.3 Or, submit a registration form to the Regatta Committee mailbox in the clubhouse by 6:00pm on Saturday, May 30th. Registration forms are available at the clubhouse back door bulletin board.
- 3.4 Entries received after these deadlines will incur a late fee of \$5.00

4 Schedule

- 4.1 Sunday, May 31, 2026:
 - 1100 Skippers Meeting/Late Registration
 - 1145 Registration ends
 - 1155 Scheduled first warning

5 Start

- 5.1 Starting signals will be made in accordance with Racing Rules of Sailing Rule 26.

6 Courses and Marks

- 6.1 The course and marks will be announced at the skippers meeting.

7 Assignment to Division/Scoring

Divisions and start sequence for this event will consist of:

Start	Division	Scheduled Warning
1	PHRF	1155

8 Scoring

8.1 The event format and scoring method will be announced at the Skippers Meeting:

8.1.1 Handicap divisions may be scored PHRF Time on Time.

8.1.2 Or, the event may be a reverse-handicap pursuit race.

9 Awards

Awards will be presented to each division on the following basis: One to three yachts registered: first place only; Four to six yachts registered: first and second place; More than six yachts registered: first through third place.

10 Communications

Notices on race day will be posted on the notice board/window left of the main clubhouse entrance facing the harbor no later than 30 minutes before the first warning signal.

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
