I, the parent/guardian have legal custody of the minor. I hereby authorize a responsible adult to act as my nominated person at H Class Junior Championship and/or H Class Championship. I agree that this authorization shall remain in effect for the duration of the minor's participation in the event and related activities and shall not be revoked before the end of the event. I authorize transport of the minor to hospital and to make any health care or/and surgical operations that would seem necessary.

I will be responsible for the minor throughout the event, and during the time the minor is afloat I will be available at the event venue. I accept responsibility for the competitor's decision to participate in accordance with Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 3 and RRS 4 as well as for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event.

I appoint the person named below, who has agreed to act in loco parentis (designated adult). He/she will be responsible for my dependent throughout the event. During the time my dependent is afloat he/she will be available at the event venue. The designated adult accepts responsibility for the competitor's decision to participate in accordance with racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 3 and RRS 4 as well as for all actions of the competitor during any activity related to the event.

Disclaimer of Liability:

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm the boat is fit for those conditions and they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing.
