NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC), 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292. (310) 827-7692.

1. Rules:

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed herein or by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

2 Eligibility:

- 2.1 This race is open to PHRF, Cruiser and One Design classes.
- 2.2 To be eligible for entry, each boat must:

- (a) be entered by an individual who is a member of US Sailing or other organization affiliated with US Sailing, SCYA or their own National Authority; and
- (b) have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate or a member in good standing of a one design fleet. If there is not 3 or more One Design boats to form a class then those competitors shall be entered and scored in either the PHRF or cruiser handicapped class with a PHRF SoCal rating equivalent whether or not this boat has a valid PHRF SoCal certificate

3 Entry:

- 3.1 Eligible boats must enter the race online at Regatta Network - <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/31049>
- 3.3 Entries must be received by 1800 on Saturday, April 18, 2026.
- 3.4 The entry fee is \$35.00

4 Classes:

- 4.1 Classes will be established for PHRF, Cruiser and One Design based upon the entries.
- 4.2 A minimum of 3 paid entries will be required to establish a class. Entrants of a class that has not met the minimum may be assigned to another appropriate class.
- 4.3 Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted on the official notice board at Regatta Network, <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/31049>

4. Schedule:

The scheduled time of the 1st Warning Signal is 1225. Three races are scheduled for PHRF and One Design classes. Two races are scheduled for Cruising Classes

5. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be available on the Regatta Network event website page at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/31049> no later than 1800 hours on Friday April 18, 2026 and at www.smwyc.org/racing

7. The Courses:

Courses will be set using marks on Course Chart 18 and /or marks set by Race Committee.

8. Scoring:

8.1 All race scores will count. This changes RRS A2.1

8.2 PHRF Classes and Cruiser Classes will use So Cal PHRF Area B Ratings.

8.3 Scoring for PHRF classes and Cruiser Classes will be calculated using the time on distance method.

8.4 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9. Awards:

Trophies will be presented for each class at SMWYC after racing.
