2026 Spring Club Series

NOTICE OF RACE

(v15 effective March 14, 2026)

Event: 2026 Spring Club Series, Board Boats

Dates: March 14, 2026, to May 9, 2026

Host: Lake Canyon Yacht Club, Canyon Lake, TX

Eligibility: The series is open to all Boat classes.

Racing Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2025 – 2028, this Notice (except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instruction associated with this series), the current version of the Canyon Lake Sailing Instructions, and, if sailing in a One-Design fleet, the applicable Class rules. This event is classified as a category “A” event. Any additional information will be posted on the Official Notice window of the LCYC Clubhouse.

Youth Sailors: All sailors 18 and under must provide signed parental approval and release. Forms are available on the LCYC web site and can also be signed on the day of the race.

Scoring: Low point system is outlined in Appendix A of RRS. Single Day entrants will be scored separately from Series Entrants.

Proposed Classes: Flying Scot, Laser, Sunfish, Aero, Catamaran, Portsmouth, Catalina 22. Three (3) boats of a class or similar constitute a fleet. Actual fleets will be set and announced at the Skipper’s Meeting. No fleets will be formed after the Skipper’s Meeting.

Races: At least Three (3) races are scheduled each Saturday, for a target of six (6) to nine (9) races for the series. Four (4) races may be run each race day at the discretion of the race committee. One race shall constitute the series. When fewer than 5 races have been completed for the series, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 5 to 6 races have been completed for the series, a boat’s series score will be the total of her best 4 race scores. When 7 to 8 races have been completed for the series, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst 2 scores. When 9 or more races have been completed for the series, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

Courses: The course for each race will be posted on the stern of the committee boat before each race. The course for each race shall be at the discretion of the Principal Race Official present.

Trophies: The number of series trophies will be determined by the number of boats entered in each fleet by the Skipper's Meeting. 1-3 boats = 1 trophy, 4-6 boats = 2 trophies, and 7 or more boats = 3 trophies. Trophy winners are requested to attend Awards ceremony, or to send a representative. Trophies will not necessarily be retained for future distribution if unclaimed. No trophies will be awarded to single-day entrants.

Refreshments: Beer, soda & snacks following racing. Trophy presentation will be held after the race on May 9, 2026.
