

2010 ATLANTIC COAST LASER MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS

AMENDED NOTICE OF RACE

Event: 2010 Atlantic Coast Laser Masters Championships

Place: Wianno Yacht Club, 101 Bridge Street, Osterville, Massachusetts

Date: August 28 -29, 2010

Organizing Authority: Wianno Yacht Club

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the prescription of US Sailing, except as modified by these Sailing Instructions, any amendments thereto, and the rules of the Laser class (except as any of these are altered by these Sailing Instructions).
- 1.2 Sailors shall wear a properly fastened USCG approved personal flotation device at all times while racing.
- 1.3 All Masters may switch between standard and radial rigs during the regatta provided the sail numbers remain the same and the switch occurs on land.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 Open to all Laser Class Sailors who are members of the International Laser Class and meet the Class Mandated Age to qualify as "Master" as of August 28, 2010.

35-44 for Apprentices,
45-54 for Masters,
55-64 for Grand Masters, and
65 and over for Great Grand Masters.

3. ENTRY, CHECK-IN & SAILING INSTRUCTION AVAILABILITY:

- 3.1 Eligible sailors may enter by completing an online registration at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html>
- 3.2 All sailors must complete a liability waiver.
- 3.3 Sailing Instructions are available online and will be available in hard copy at the Wianno Yacht Club on August 28, 2010.

4. ENTRY FEE AND PAYMENT:

- 4.1 \$75.00 to be paid online or by check or cash on Saturday August 28, 2010.

5. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, August 28, 2010:	0800-1000	On-site check-in and late registration

6. RACING AREAS AND COURSES:

The racing area will be approximately one mile south of the breakwater at the entrance to West Bay in Osterville, MA.

The courses will be windward-leeward.

7. SCORING:

The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the RRS will apply with one throw-out if 5 or more races are completed.

8. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES:

The Two-Turns Penalty (720 degrees) of PRRS 44.2 will apply.

9. DISPOSAL OF WASTE OR TRASH:

Competitors observed discharging trash over the side shall be either disqualified from all races sailed on the day the infraction is observed or be subject to other suitable disciplinary action, or both.

10. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded for:

First overall (handicap);
First through Third (A, M, GM, GGM);
First Woman (handicap)

(Apprentices add 3 points per race to their score, Masters 2 points, Grand Masters 1 point, and great Grand Masters 0 points. This system is used to determine the overall winner, the first female, and the overall standings.)
