NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.3 The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May.
- 1.4 The event will be held on the ocean off Cape May inlet (conditions permitting) or Cape May Harbor.

2. FLEET ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Laser, Radial and Laser 4.7 competitors who are members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association may enter by completing registration with the Corinthian Yacht Club. A minimum of five entries are required to constitute a class. Athletes can verify membership with the NA Laser Class via this link:

3. RISK

3.1 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Required Fees: The entry fee is \$55.00 USD if paid before 9/21 (After 9/21, the entry fee will be \$60.00). Checks should be made payable to "Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May".

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available during on-site registration. Courses configurations will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.
- 7.2 There will be one discard when five or more races are completed.

8. AWARDS

- 8.1 Laser fleet: First through Fifth place, First Junior, First Master, First Grand Master, and First Woman.
- 8.2 Radial Fleet: First through Fourth place.
- 8.3 4.7 Fleet: Top finisher.
