

# NOTICE OF RACE



## LIYC – MIDWINTER TUNE-UP REGATTA Sunday – January 23, 2011 (For Juniors & Seniors - Notice of Race)



- 
1. GOVERNING RULES      The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of each class, except as any of these are changed by this NOR, or other sailing instructions delivered by the Race Committee.
  
  2. ELIGIBILITY ENTRY      The regatta is open to the following classes: Lido 14, Laser, Laser Radial, CFJ, Adult Sabot, Sabot A, B, C-1, C-2 & C-3, and any other class of 3 or more boats. Each skipper must be a member of US Sailing, a recognized yacht club, and comply with the rules of the class in which he or she is sailing. Eligible yachts may enter by completing the entry from on the [US Sailing/Regatta Network](#) website for "Upcoming Events" or by completing and filing a written entry form in the LIYC Board/Room/Club House prior to the Skipper's Meeting on Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. There is no fee for this regatta. Yachts sailing without having completed and filed an entry form will not be scored.
  
  3. RACE SCHEDULE

*There will be four (4) consecutive races with no throw-out race. There will be no lunch break between races. Snacks provided by LIYC immediately after the last race. Trophies will be presented immediately following any Protest Committee activity.*
  
  4. BOAT LAUNCHING      Boats can be launched at the Genoa Boat Gardens located at the corner of Via Lido Soud and Via Genoa (a crane is available with advance request), and at the LIYC Clubhouse on Via Lido Soud and Via San Remo. Please remember not to park in the red and/or in front of a garage or driveway on Lido Isle – thank you.
  
  5. SNACK BAR      The snack bar will be open for participants and guests to purchase a hot or cold lunch. Cash only is accepted at the snack bar.
  
  6. SKIPPER'S MEETING      There will be a mandatory Skipper's Meeting for all classes at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> at the LIYC Clubhouse. The Race Committee may change the content of this NOR in writing or by verbal instruction. Each Skipper is responsible for obtaining a course chart from the Race Committee. Course charts will be available in the LIYC Board Room / Clubhouse.
  
  7. SCORING      The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS, will apply. Each yacht's total score will be the cumulative sum total of all races.
  
  8. RACE AREA  
    /COURSES      The starting area will be on the bay off the LIYC Race Tower. Individual race courses will be selected by the Race Committee from the LIYC course chart.
  
  9. PROTESTS/TROPHIES      Protests shall be written and filed on RC forms available in the LIYC Boardroom and must be filed by a competitor within thirty (30) minutes of the last race. Snacks provided by LIYC immediately after the last race. Trophies will be presented immediately following any Protest Committee activity.
