The Organizing Authority is the International 29er Class Association. The event is hosted by the Coconut Grove Sailing Club.

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all 29erXX boats of the International 29er Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter via online registration posted from www.29erxxregattas.org
- 3.3 **Parent/Guardian Declarations**: All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit signed Parent/Guardian Declarations either by post or at registration.

4 FEES

4.1 An entry fee of \$125 per boat shall be collected from each team. Participants may register online via the link from the website: <u>www.29erxxregattas.org</u>. Entries will be accepted until 1200 February 4, 2011.

5 FORMAT OF RACING

5.1 The Regatta will consist of a single series of races.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 Scheduled first Warning Signal will be at 1330 on Friday February 4th and 1030 on Saturday February 5th and 1100 Sunday February 6th.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7.2 In the case where the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions do not agree, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The course area will be on Biscayne Bay.
- 8.2 The Host Club, Coconut Grove Sailing Club, is located at 2990 South Bayshore Drive, Miami, FL 33133.

9 COURSES

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward courses. The race target time will be 30 minutes.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 When fewer than five races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2 When from five to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3 When nine or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 PRIZES

12.1 Trophies to the top two finishing teams. Other prizes may be awarded in addition.

13 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

13.1 Competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor the Host Club will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.
