

2011 SUPERBOWL CHARITY REGATTA

Benefiting the Wellness Community Presented by SMWYC and MdR Lido 14 Fleet 2 Sunday, January 30, 2011

NOTICE OF RACE

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

Eligibility and entry: This racing series is open to all boats of the Lido 14 Class Association and guests of Lido 14 Fleet 2. Invitations have been made to dinghies, multi-hulls and keelboats.

Entries will be held online at www.regattanetwork.com. There is no required entry fee but the suggested contribution to enter the regatta shall be \$10.00 payable to the Wellness Community. This is a charity event and the contribution fee is optional. Please enter prior to January 27, 2011 after which date a \$10.00 late entry fee will apply.

Divisions: It is intended to have one start for all Lido sailors. If event participation warrants it, separate starts may be implemented for A & B fleets at the discretion of the race committee. The race committee shall establish an order of starts no later than 1030 hours the morning of the race. Three boats are required to create a class, all efforts will be made to accommodate any entrant.

Location: Racing will be held in Marina del Rey. Courses and venues will be determined by the number of classes that enter. Course charts will be available along with Sailing Instructions no later than 10:00 hours the morning of the regatta. The first race is scheduled to start in the vicinity of Burton Chase Park.

Skipper's meeting: A skipper's meeting will be held at SMWYC at 1000 hours the morning of the regatta. All participants are extremely encouraged to attend.

The Start: Starts will be administered in accordance with Rule 26 of the *RRS*, for keelboats, Appendix S of the *RRS* shall be used for dinghies that sail inside of the detached breakwater. The first warning signal is scheduled for 11:55. The start and finish line for all classes will be in the vicinity of Burton Chase Park.

Scoring: Scoring shall be by the Low Point System as defined in the *RRS*. Race Committee will attempt to hold up to three races for keelboats and up to five races for dinghies. One race shall constitute a regatta.

Launching: Hoists are available at both SMWYC, 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, 310-827-7692, www.smwyc.org and South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club (SCCYC), 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, www.sccyc.org. Boats may also be trailer launched at a public launch ramp across from SCCYC for a fee of \$7.00.

Awards and Hospitality: A Tex Mex themed dinner (feast). Results and multiple awards shall be presented at the SMWYC Clubhouse following the event.
