6 Measurement

Crew will be weighed during Registration hours on Thursday, Apr 21 and Friday, Apr 22. Persons requiring boat measurement should contact fleet captain Roger Dougal (dougal@cec.sc.edu) to obtain a list of available class measurers.

7 Sailing Instructions

Available at the registration table after 1400 on Apr 21, 2011, or from the regatta web site after Mar 15.

8 Courses

Courses will be windward/leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions, on the waters of Lake Murray.

9 Scoring and Penalty System Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores using Appendix A4 "Low Point System" with no throwouts. This changes Appendix A2. Race committee will attempt to set as many races as are practical. Three races constitute a series. The percentage penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply.

10 Launching, Hauling, Docking, Parking A crane will be available to launch and haul during the following hours (approximately): Thursday 4 to 6 PM, Friday 8-11 AM, and Sunday following the last race. There is no lifting charge. A gin pole is available. Yachts must be wet sailed during the Regatta. Berthing will be provided at the Columbia Sailing Club. The order of haul out after the regatta will be based on bow numbers, assigned according to order of receipt of pre-registrations. Parking, launching, and docking instructions will be provided at the club entrance. Boats may be parked at the club before or after the regatta for up to two weeks with advance approval.

11 Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the top six boats, with crew trophies for the top 3 boats. First place trophies for individual races will be awarded daily. Also, the 1st place winner's name will be engraved on CSC's *Perlita Trophy* and on the J/24 perpetual trophy. The highest placing member of Fleet 67 will be similarly recognized on Fleet 67's perpetual trophy.
