NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012.
- 1.2. The rules of the INSA Class, the North Series Standing Rules as published in the 2010 SCYYRA Year Book and the 2010-11 North Perpetual Trophy Series Notice of Race, the Notice of Race published for this event (except where modified by the Sailing Instructions) will apply.
- 1.3. The INSA Gross Weight Rule will apply for all "A" skippers; no other class weight rules will be enforced.

2 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to INSA Class boats that meet the following requirements:
 - 2.1.1. The skipper shall be a member of an SCYA or SCYYRA recognized yacht club.
 - 2.1.2. Skippers must be a member in good standing of the INSA Class.
- 2.2. The entry fee for the regatta will be \$40, which includes a t-shirt and lunches. Entries received after 1600hrs January 7, 2011 shall be subject to a \$10 late fee and correct shirt size may not be guaranteed.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by registering online at www.sdyc.org/juniors.

3 NORTH SERIES COMPETITORS

- 3.1. North Series competitors will sail in A fleet only. 2010-2011 North Series competitors will have entered the series at the ABYC Fall Invitational or MBYC Jr. Commodore's Regatta. Their scores will be carried forward to NHYC Spring Gold Cup.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Saturday, January 15, 2011
 - Check-In 0930-1020
 - Skippers Meeting 1030
 - First Warning 1130
 - Subsequent races to follow ASAP
 - A lunch break will be scheduled at the discretion of the PRO

Sunday, January 16, 2011

- First Warning 1100
- Subsequent races to follow ASAP
- A lunch break will be scheduled at the discretion of the PRO
- No race will be started after 1530hrs on Sunday
- A trophy ceremony will follow promptly after racing.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on Saturday.

6 COMPETITORS' MEETING

6.1. A competitors' meeting will be held on the sail wash lawn at 1030 on Saturday.

7 VENUE

7.1. The intended course area will be in the basin to the south of the San Diego Yacht Club.

8 THE COURSES

8.1. A course chart will be provided in the sailing instructions.

9 RACES

9.1. Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26 modified so that the warning signal shall be given three minutes before the starting signal

9.2. A maximum of 10 races may be sailed.

10 SCORING

10.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A shall apply as modified by 10.2.

10.2. Two races must be completed to constitute a series. After six races are completed a boat's worst score will be excluded from her series' score.

11 COACH BOATS

11.1. Coaching is not allowed while competitors are racing, except in the C3 division for competitors who are substantially behind the fleet.

12 TROPHIES

12.1. Trophies will be presented to the top competitors in each fleet.

13 HOSPITALITY

13.1. Lunch will be provided both days, as well as a snack during trophy presentation.
