2011 COMMODORES REGATTA Sunday March 27, 2011

1 Rules

- 1.1 This Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 This regatta will feature a reverse start, with the starting time for each boat related to the Monterey Bay PHRF rating assigned to the boat. The higher handicap boats start earlier, followed by boats with decreasing handicaps.
- 1.4 The complete text of the above changes will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to any boat holding a valid 2011 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at Regatta Network.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Regular entry fee is \$40 if received by 2000 hours March 26, 2011. Late entry fee is (\$65). Entry fees are payable to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.

4 Schedule

- 4.1 Late registration: Sunday March 27, 2011 from 1015 hours to 1055 hours.
- 4.2 One race will be held on Sunday March 27, 2011.
- 4.3 A Competitors Meeting will be held at 1100 hours on Sunday March 27, 2011 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.5 An Awards Ceremony will take place at the SCYC Clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions & Courses

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions, including courses to be sailed will be available at the Competitors meeting.

6 Venues

- 6.1 Racing will be around buoy-enclosed courses, between Capitola and Natural Bridges, and within approximately 2.5 miles from the SC Small Craft Harbor.

7 Divisions

- 7.1 Racing will be in the following divisions: A Fleet (PHRF <88), B Fleet (PHRF >89), Double-Handed, Jib & Main (PHRF <181) and Jib & Main (PHRF >182).
- 7.2 To receive a start and be scored, a division must have a minimum of three boats.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Boats entered in divisions with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
