Notice of Race

2011 Laser NorCals Championships & US
Sailing Area G Elimination for the 2011
U.S. Singlehanded Men's and Women's
Sailing Championships
April 2 & 3 2011

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* the class rules of the ILCA.
- 1.2. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4. Competitors in all classes are required to carry a bowline of at least fifteen feet attached to a towing point while racing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to Laser, Radial, and Laser 4.7 classes. A minimum of five boats in each class must be registered by Thursday March 31, 2011 to qualify for a class start.
- 2.2. All competitors must be members of the ILCA-NA or their national Laser Class Association.
- 2.3. To be eligible for the Men's or Women's US Sailing divisions of the Laser and Radial classes, respectively, competitors must meet the eligibility requirements of the 2011 U.S. Singlehanded Men's and Women's Championships NOR.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may register by completing the online entry form at www.scyc.org or at Regatta Network http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html.
- 2.5. Competitors under the age of 18 must complete the Parental Release & Medical Waiver signed by their parent or guardian. The signed waivers shall be provided to the SCYC race committee prior to 1030 April 2, 2011.

3. Fees

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$60.00 if received prior to 2000 hours April 1.
- 3.2. A late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed to all entries received after April 1, 2011 2000 hours.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Registration will be April 2, 2011 between 1000 and 1030 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 4.2. There will be a competitors briefing April 2, 2011 at 1030 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 4.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal April 2 & 3, 2011 is 1225.
- 4.4. An awards presentation will follow racing on April 3, 2011.
- 4.5. Six races are scheduled, three on April 2nd and three on April 3rd.
- 4.6. Participants and their guests are invited to attend a social event at the SCYC yacht club after racing on Saturday. (one meal ticket included with entry fee)

5. Measurement

5.1. Sail numbers shall be in accordance with ILCA class rules.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 1030 on April 2, 2011 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club and may be posted on the club website.

7. Venue

- 7.1. Registration, the competitors briefing, launching, and awards will be held at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Figure 1: Driving Directions shows the location of the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.




Figure 2: Approximate Racing Area

- 7.2. Figure 2: Approximate Racing Area shows the approximate location of the racing.

8. The Courses

8.1. Courses will be windward - leeward courses around temporary inflatable marks.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3. When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. Support Boats

10.1. All coach and support boats must register with the race committee before the start of the regatta and monitor a VHF radio. VHF channel will be assigned at the competitor's meeting. They are restricted to outside the race area during all races and may be called upon to assist as a support boat at any time.

11. Prizes

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on early registration.
- 11.2. The highest placing finisher in the Men's US Sailing division of the Laser class will have a berth in the 2011 U.S. Singlehanded Men's Sailing Championships.
- 11.3. The highest placing finisher in the Women's US Sailing division of the Radial class will have a berth in the 2011 U.S. Singlehanded Women's Sailing Championships.

1: Start out going SOUTH follow CA-17 S.	I on CA-1 N/CA-17 S. Continue to	0.3 mi
2: CA-17 S becomes OC	EAN ST.	1.2 mi
3: Turn LEFT onto E CLI	FF DR.	0.3 mi
4: Stay STRAIGHT to go	onto MURRAY ST.	0.2 mi
5: Turn RIGHT onto SEA	BRIGHT AVE.	0.2 mi
6: Turn LEFT onto ATLA	NTIC AVE.	0.2 mi
7: Turn LEFT onto MARI	NER PARK WAY.	0.0 mi
8: End at Mariner Park W	/ay Santa Cruz, CA	

B: Mariner Park Way , Santa Cruz, CA
