Location: SailMaine East End Beach, Portland, Maine

1. General Information, Eligibility, and Rules:

- a. The races will be conducted under the 2009 2012 Racing Rules of Sailing as adopted by US Sailing, the Rules of the USODA, Club 420, and International Laser Class Associations, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- b. Age limit: Sailors aged 8 18 (birthdate after July 13, 1992)

2. Classes and Divisions:

- a. **Green Fleet Optimist:** Please refer to USODA Rules for Green Fleet classification. There will be a separate Green Fleet Optimist group with quality training by a Green Fleet mentor and racing on a separate course in a fun atmosphere. Green Fleet participants will receive participation awards.
- b. **Green Fleet 420 Fleet**: There will be a separate Green Fleet 420 division. This fleet will not use spinnaker or trapeze.
- c. **Fleet caps**: The hosts are limiting the size of the fleets to ensure safe, quality races.
 - Green Fleet Optimist = 50 boats
 - RWB Fleet Optimist = 50 boats
 - Green Fleet 420 = 40 boats
 - 420 Race Fleet = 60 boats
 - Laser (radial/full rig) = 60 boats combined

For a Fleet to be eligible, a minimum of 10 boats for its Fleet must be registered by 12:00 noon July 11, 2011.

6. Coaches and Adult Supervision

It is REQUIRED that all sailors attending this regatta have an adult (coach, parent, etc.) that is responsible for them ON THE WATER and on shore throughout this event.

- a. Each club or sailing association is recommended to bring a support boat for their sailors.
- b. Individual sailors are encouraged to have a support boat as well but if not available will be assigned one from the coach and support fleet for the regatta. Contact PJYC Director Kelly Franklin for more information: pycjuniorsailing@gmail.com
- c. Coach and support boats may have additional competitor boats assigned them for the regatta. Coach and support boats may be directed by the Race Committee or Safety Boats to assist in the management of the races and safety of the sailors as the needs arise.
- d. All coach, support, and spectator boats MUST have a working VHF radio on board to monitor the event or that boat will not be allowed in the sailing area.

7. Other:

- a. Launching:
 - 1. All Fleets will be launching and retrieving at East End Beach.
 - 2. All Powerboats will be launched at Portland Yacht Services. NO EXCEPTIONS.
 - 3. All trailers will be stored at PYS. NO EXCEPTIONS, they'll be towed from EEB.

b. Safety Check:

- 1. <u>Optimists</u>: The hosts will be completing a safety check on all Optimists Monday afternoon and Tuesday morning. This is required before Optimist sailors are permitted to race.
- 2. <u>420s/Lasers</u>: We will be completing random checks on the 420 and Laser Fleets throughout the Regatta to ensure the boats and sailors are safe.

c. Dollies:

It is strongly encouraged and appreciated if all sailboats have dollies. For safety reasons, dollies are needed for all boats to ensure a quick exit from the water in the case of a storm, etc.
