Finish:	SATURDAY: Between an orange flag on Race Committee boat and dropped orange mark. If shortened, all classes finish between a mark of the original course and orange flag on Race Committee boat.
	SUNDAY: Between an orange flag on the TAYC balcony and Mark "N" (R "2"). If course is shortened, finish between last mark of shortened course and Race Committee boat.
Time Limit:	3 hours for each race.
Protests:	Written protest must be delivered to Race Committee within 1 hour of the Race Committee boat reaching the dock Saturday or the last boat finishing the race Sunday. Protests heard as soon as possible after the last race of the day.
Awards:	Awards will be given at the clubhouse after Sunday's racing.
