RULES:

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules Of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS), and the rules of the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (STCR), except as any of these are altered by this Notice, and the Sailing Instructions which will be available before the regatta on www.tayc.com and at Registration.

ELIGIBILITY:

Entries eligible in accordance with STCR 21, 26, 29 and 30

Registration is also available at Tred Avon YC from 0800 to 0900, Saturday, October 1st

No fee for sailing Friday only. Please sign-in at club.

SCHEDULE:

Sept. 30 1200 Club opens for arrivals
1600 First warning for Woodies/Classic race. No start after 1800
1830 Sponsored social/dinner, cash bar, awards for Friday races.

Skippers Meeting 0900
First Warning 1055
1800 Dinner, cash bar

Oct. 2 First Warning 1025

FEES:

Entry fee: \$130 for Fall Wind-Up and Social events for skipper and one crew.
Friday's woodie and classics racing is free.

MEASUREMENT:

Boat and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.

RACING AREA:

Friday's racing of the classics and woodies will be off the club, in view of the deck and property. Sat and Sun racing will be in the Choptank river, south of the Choptank River Light.

COURSES:

Courses and procedures will be according to STCR 34. STCR 34.7 Format C shall apply.

SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System, RRS A, will apply, modified so that each series score will be the total of her races scores with her worst score excluded if more than four (4) races are completed, of which three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

TROPHIES:

There will be trophies for Friday's racing, Friday evening. Sat and Sun's trophies will be for the Jack Streeton Trophy, 1st-3rd places, plus a Novice Trophy will be awarded. A Classic Trophy will be awarded to the best boat below 7300 or the lowest boat number whichever is higher.

LAUNCHING:

Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers to be stored in designated area clear of the hoist and access lanes. No Vehicles may drive on the dock.

HOUSING:

Housing may be available on a first come, first serve basis. Please contact andrewbparish@gmail.com for info.
