Notice of Race

1. Rules

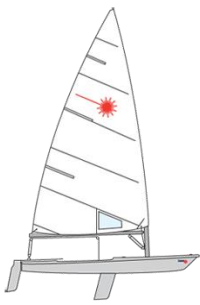
- 1.1 The organizing authority of the regatta is SailLaser LLC in conjunction with ILCA District 13.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*.
- 1.3 International Laser Class Association (ILCA) rules will apply.
- 1.4 Competitors must wear CG approved PFD's.

2. Eligibility, Entry and Fees

- 2.1 The races are open to boats meeting the requirements of the ILCA.
- 2.2 This regatta is open to all Laser sailors meeting these requirements.
- 2.3 All entries must be made online at: <http://www.regattanetwork.com/>
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 9:00 A.M. Saturday May 7th.
- 2.5 The entry fee is **\$95** and includes full use of the facilities of U.S. Sailing Center Miami, cold breakfast buffet each day, 2 tickets to LaserPerformance products raffle and a regatta shirt (guaranteed for the first 50 entries).
- 2.6 Any boats that will arrive prior to the 5th or will stay later than the 10th shall check in with the U.S. Sailing Center and pay an additional storage fee.

3. Fleets and Divisions

- 3.1 The Standard Rig and Radial may be divided into separate fleets with their own starts at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 3.2 All hails will use the last 4 digits of the sail number.
- 3.3 Competitors' cannot change rigs. (Rig-Swapping Rule off).

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at Skippers' Meeting.

6. Venue and Social Schedule

- 6.1 The location of this regatta will be at SailLaser Miami, inside the U.S. Sailing Center Miami. Competition will take place at Biscayne Bay.
- 6.2 Saturday and Sunday: Cold Breakfast Buffet from 8:00 A.M. – 9:30 A.M.

7. Courses

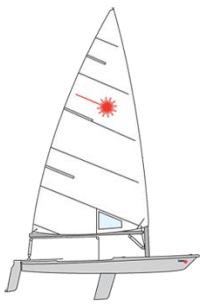
The course to be sailed will be Trapezoid and Windward/Leeward

8. Scoring

- 8.1 Six (6) races are scheduled. One race is required to constitute a regatta
- 8.2 The worst score will be excluded with the completion of six (6) races.

9. Prizes

Laser: 1st – 5th, Laser Radial: 1st – 5th, Women: 1st – 3th
Apprentice Master: 1st, Master: 1st, Grand Master: 1st, Great Grand Master: 1st
Junior 17-: 1st



Final decisions on racing classes will be made by the Race committee and announced at the Skippers meeting.

Decisions made by the Race Committee or the Protest Committee are final.
