- 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY The regatta is open to the J/22, Rhodes 19, Flying Scot, Fish Boat, Lightning, Melges 24, Star, Vanguard 15, Finn, Laser, Laser Radial, 420, Sunfish, Ensign, Optimist, and Optimist Green Fleet Classes, and any other established one design classes. Four boats are required to qualify as a class, but fewer than four boats may be given a start at the Race Committee's discretion.
