Notice of Race

2011 Friday Evening Laser Series #2

June 3, 10, 17, 24, 2011

1. Rules

- 1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, and the class rules of the International Laser Association. Competitors in all classes are required to carry a bowline of at least fifteen feet attached to a towing point while racing.
- 1.2. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. RRS 41.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility, Entry and Fees

- 2.1. This series is open to Laser and Laser Radial classes.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register [online](#) or by filling out the 2011 Friday Evening Laser Series #2 form and presenting it to a race committee officer at the SCYC boat hoist before 17:15 on June 3, 2011.
- 2.3. Late entries may register on scheduled race evenings at SCYC boat hoist. Late entry fee is \$30.00. Race committee will have registration forms available.
- 2.4. The entry fee is \$30. Competitors age 35 and under at the date of the first race of the series will be will receive a \$20 discount on their entry fee.

3. Schedule

- 3.1. There will be a competitors briefing June 3, 2011 at 17:15 at the SCYC boat hoist.
- 3.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal each day is 18:30. No races will be started after 20:00 each race day. Five races are scheduled for each race day.
- 3.3. An awards presentation will follow racing on June 24, 2011 at the clubhouse.

4. Sailing Instructions

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration at the SCYC boat hoist and posted on the club website (scyc.org).

5. Venue

- 5.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

6. The Course

- 6.1. Courses will be windward leeward courses around temporary inflatable marks.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. Three races will constitute a series.
- 7.2. There will be no throw outs. This changes RRS A2.

8. Prizes

- 8.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
