2011 Snipe District 6 / Pacific Coast Championship
June 24-26, 2011



Organizing Authorities: Coronado Yacht Club and Snipe District 6

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the Deeds of Gift for Snipe District 6 and Pacific Coast Championship Trophies.
- 1.2. This regatta is an ISAF Category A event in accordance with the current SCIRA Advertising Prescription.
- 1.3. The same skipper must sail all races; crews may be changed.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1. This regatta is open to SCIRA registered boats and skippers subject to above rules and who properly enter as set forth below.
- 2.2. This regatta is open to all SCIRA-USA registered boats and SCIRA-USA skippers, who are in good standing with SCIRA-USA for the current year.

3. Entry, Fees, & Registration

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing an Entry Form and submitting the Entry Fee as follows:

On-Line: Register at Coronado Yacht Club website: <http://race.coronadoyc.org/> Click on **Registration**, then click **Register Online** (next to CYC Small Boat Regatta)

On-Site: Submit a completed Entry Form along with the required Entry Fee in person during On-Site Registration from 0900 to 1030 in the Coronado Yacht Club main clubhouse on Friday, June 24th. Saturday morning registration will be available on request.

- 3.2. The Entry Fee is \$60.00, paid by credit card, cash or check.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. A Competitor's Meeting is scheduled for 1100 on Friday, June 24, 2011 at Coronado Yacht Club.
- 4.2. The scheduled time for the Warning Signal for the first race on Friday is 1300. On Saturday and Sunday the first race will start at 1200. Subsequent races will be started as soon as possible after completion of the first race of each day. Three races are scheduled for June 24, four races for June 25 and two races for June 26. The Race Committee reserves the right to have more or fewer races each day.

5. Measurement & Safety Requirements

All boats are required to carry all safety equipment required by SCIRA rules, including a paddle, two wearable PFDs, and an 8 mm diameter 50-foot long towline.

6. Sailing Instructions

SIs will be available at registration on Friday, June 24, 2011 Amendments to the Sailing Instructions and other notices will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board.

7. Venue

The race course will be located in South Bay.

8. Scoring

ISAF Low point scoring will be used. Nine races are scheduled. Three completed races constitute a regatta. If fewer than six races are completed, no scores will be excluded.

9. Prizes

At a minimum, prizes will be awarded to the skipper and crew of the top three finishers. The perpetual for the District 6 and Pacific Coast Champion Trophies will be presented to the top overall finisher.

10. Housing
