**1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 International Sailing Federation *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), and J/105 and J/80 Class Rules, except as modified by this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments to the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 All yachts must have the required minimum safety equipment on board as required by the US Coast Guard and the State of Rhode Island. The use by each competitor of Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices is highly recommended.

1.3 It is the sole responsibility of each Owner or Person in Charge to decide whether to start or to continue any race for any reason.

## 2. Venue and Dockage:

2.1 The sailing area will be on the West Passage of Narragansett Bay.

2.2 Dockage: The WYC docks will be available for loading and unloading only. Wickford Yacht Club expects to have a limited number of guest moorings available on a first come first served basis. Brewer Wickford Cove Marina will offer deeply discounted haul-out, power wash and dry-storage of visiting boats participating in the Sail Newport and/or Bacardi Regattas who wish to stay for the J/105 Wickford Regatta. 2.3 The Saturday dinner will be held at Wickford Yacht Club, 165 Pleasant Street, Wickford, RI.
