2011 505 PACIFIC COAST CHAMPIONSHIP

July 8^{TH} , July 9^{TH} , and July 10^{TH} 2011

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Changes to the RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 Competitors will be required to carry the following equipment: a compass, a paddle not less than 75cm in length, and a towing line not less than 10 meters long nor less than 6mm in diameter.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International 505 class. Helmspersons and crew must be current members of the International 505 class Racing Association.
- 2.2 Registration is online only. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at scyc.org or on Regatta Network.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Regular entry fee is \$100.00 if received by 2000 hours July 6th, 2011.
- 3.2 Late entry fee is (\$125.00) if received after 2000 hours July 6^{th} , 2011.
- 3.3 Entry fee includes two dinner tickets to the Saturday night taco bar and two T-shirts.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 Late registration: July 8th from 1000 hours to 1030 hours at the SCYC Club House.
- 4.2 A competitors meeting will be at 1030 hours on July 8th, 2011 at the SCYC Club House.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.4 Eight races are scheduled: three races July 8th, three races July 9th, and two races July 10th.
- 4.5 No warning signals will be made after 1600 hours on Sunday July 10th.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta on July 10th.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting, and will be posted on the SCYC Official Notice Board, located in the window opposite the bar at the northeast corner of SCYC club house.
- 5.2 The sailing instructions **may be** available on line at scyc.org after July 1, 2011.

6 Venue

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

7.1 Windward leeward and triangle windward leeward courses will be used. Course descriptions will be provided with the sailing instructions.

8 Scoring

8.1.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta. When fewer than six aces have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This modifies RRS A2.

9 Berthing

9.1 Trailer parking will be available at no additional cost to competitors along the west side of the West Harbor Parking lot (just to the south of the SCYC Dry Storage Yard). Look for signage on your arrival to the parking lot. Competitors must purchase daily parking passes from the Santa Cruz Port District for parking in the Santa Cruz Harbor parking lots.

10 Prizes

10.1 Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.


