1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) is International Mobjack Class Association in conjunction with Old Dominion University Sailing.
- 1.3 The International Mobjack Class Rules shall apply

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the International Mobjack Class.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing registration online at [Regatta Networks](http://regatta.networks.com), linked at <http://mobjack.tripod.com>, and the Sailing page at www.odusports.com.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fees of \$100.00 per boat shall be paid prior to the end of registration, (discount for US Sailing membership). Class membership fees may be collected by the class representative prior to the competitor's meeting.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 9:00am on August 20.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 The Old Dominion University Sailing Center is located on the campus of Old Dominion University at the 4600 block of Powhatan Ave, Norfolk, VA
- 6.2 The racing area will be the waters of the Elizabeth River at the mouth of the Lafayette River

7 SCORING

- 7.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - 7.2.1. When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - 7.2.2. When six or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - 7.2.3. Seven races are scheduled (this is a limiting maximum).

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9 Clean Regatta

At all events hosted by Old Dominion University Sailing, attempts are made to run a clean regatta and minimize the impact of the event on our environment. In particular the host discourages the use of single-use disposable water bottles. A clean, filtered water source will be available for refilling reusable water bottles.
