

2011 SCYC FALL ONE DESIGN SERIES

AUGUST 20, SEPTEMBER 17, AND OCTOBER 15, 2011

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) the 2010-2011 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 5 races.
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Changes to the RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Santana 22s, Moore 24s, and Santa Cruz 27s, are eligible to participate in this series. Other one-design classes may petition to participate if a minimum of at least three (3) boats are entered prior to 1100 hours August 20th, 2011.
- 2.2 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at Regatta Network or at scyc.org

3 Fees

- 3.1 Regular entry fee is \$75.00 if received by 2000 hours August 19th, 2011.
- 3.2 Late entry fee is (\$90) if received after 2000 hours August 19th, 2011.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 Late registration: August 20th from 1030 hours to 1055 hours at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2 A competitors meeting will be at 1100 hours on August 20, 2011 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1255 hours each race day.
- 4.4 Nine races are scheduled (six for the Santana 22s); three races scheduled each race day (2 races scheduled Santana 22 each race day).
- 4.5 Four races will constitute a series.
- 4.6 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the series.

5 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting or on line at scyc.org.

6 Venue

Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys in the north end of Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

7.1 Course diagrams will be provided with the sailing instructions.

8 Scoring

8.1 When fewer than six races have been completed (four races for the Santana 22s), a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When six or more races (four or more races for Santana 22s) have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of here race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2. Races will be scored per RRS A9.

8 Prizes

9.1.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the series are eligible for the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.
