## Notice of Race

### 2011 5o5 & Multihull Fall Regatta

October 8-9, 2011

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*
- 1.2. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. RRS 41.1 will be changed for all Hobie Classes so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. RRS 61.1 (a) (2) will be changed to apply to all Hobie Classes.
- 1.5. Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to the 5o5, Weta, Formula18 Catamaran, Hobie 20, Hobie 18, and Hobie 16 classes
- 2.2. Other dinghy and multihull one-design classes with a minimum of five entries may request entry.
- 2.3. In Hobie classes at least one competitor on each boat must be a member of the Hobie Class Association of North America.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may register at online at [www.regattanetwork.com](http://www.regattanetwork.com) or at [www.scyc.org](http://www.scyc.org).

#### 3. Fees

- 3.1. Regular entry fee is \$70 for double-handed boats and \$60 for single-handed boats if received prior to 1800 hours October 5, 2011. Entry fee includes taco bar at the SCYC Clubhouse on Saturday Night.
- 3.2. Late entry fee is \$80 for double-handed boats and \$70 for single-handed boats if received after 1900 hours October 5, 2011.
- 3.3. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

#### 4. Schedule

- 4.1. Registration will be October 8, 2011 between 10:00 and 10:30 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 4.2. There will be a competitors briefing October 8, 2011 at 10:30 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 4.3. On October 8, 2011, the scheduled time of the warning signal is 12:25 and there are 5 races scheduled.
- 4.4. On October 9, 2011, the scheduled time of the warning signal is 12:25 and there are 4 races scheduled. No races will be started after 15:30.
- 4.5. On each day with the warning signal for each succeeding race will be made as soon as possible after the preceding race.
- 4.6. An awards presentation will follow racing on October 9, 2011.

#### 5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors briefing and may be posted on line at [www.scyc.org](http://www.scyc.org).

#### 6. Venue and Courses

- 6.1. Registration, the competitors briefing, launching, and awards will be held at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. [Figure 1: Driving Directions](#) shows the location of the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 6.2. Racing will be around buoy enclosed courses, between Capitola and Natural Bridges in an area approximately 2.5 miles radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

#### 7. Scoring

- 7.1. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.2. When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 7.3. Hobie one-design classes, including Hobie one-design classes within the Formula18 class, scores will be submitted to the Hobie Class Association – North America rankings.



7.4. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on early registration.

	1: Start out going SOUTH on CA-1 N/CA-17 S. Continue to follow CA-17 S.	0.3 mi
	2: CA-17 S becomes OCEAN ST.	1.2 mi
	3: Turn LEFT onto E CLIFF DR.	0.3 mi
	4: Stay STRAIGHT to go onto MURRAY ST.	0.2 mi
	5: Turn RIGHT onto SEABRIGHT AVE.	0.2 mi
	6: Turn LEFT onto ATLANTIC AVE.	0.2 mi
	7: Turn LEFT onto MARINER PARK WAY.	0.0 mi
	8: End at Mariner Park Way Santa Cruz, CA
