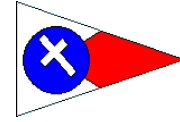

2011 FALL JACK & JILL REGATTA

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2011

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) the 2010-2011 SCYC Minimum Equipment Requirements (MER) as they apply to category 5.
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3 Changes to the RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2 Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 2.1 Boats holding a valid 2011 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 2.2 There will be PHRF divisions as follows: spinnaker, non-spinnaker and families with children under the age of 12. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except for the family division. Final division assignments will be made at the competitors meeting.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may register at www.regattanetwork.com or at www.scyc.org.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Regular entry fee is \$45 if received by 1800 hours October 7th, 2011.
- 3.2 Late entry fee is \$55.00 if received after 1800 hours October 7th 2011.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 1030 hours October 8, 2011.
- 3.4 All entry fees are non refundable.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1100 hours on October 8, 2010 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3 One race is scheduled.
- 4.4 One race will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting. They may be posted earlier on the SCYC website.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 2.5 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

7 Scoring

- 7.1 No score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
