2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, ENTRY FEE & AWARDS

- 2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors under the age of 19 and who have not yet entered college. Participants should be members of an SCYA or SCYYRA organization.
- 2.2. Competitors must enter both the individual regatta and the Hamlin Series. To enter the Series, a competitor must register via the internet at www.scyyra.org. A competitor may enter the series at the first or second scheduled regatta, but no later than the start of the first race of the second regatta. Competitors will receive 1) email receipt of successful on-line entry and 2) email notification for registration changes.
- 2.3. There will be a \$30 per person series entry fee payable online to SCYYRA. The Series entry fee includes T-shirts for each helmsman and crew.
- 2.4. Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 places in the Series for helmsman and crew.
- 2.5. The helmsman and crew will be scored separately in the (4) events. At the end of the fourth event the low point winners of the series, will be the Hamlin series champions.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

Competitors (Helmsman & crew) must be members in good standing of the 29er Class Association. Membership can be obtained on the North American 29er website at www.29ernorthamerican.org.

4. RULES

Each regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012*, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Series Standing Rules as published in the 2012 SCYYRA Year Book; the 29er Class Rules; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions issued by each club.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each race tabulated only against other Series entrants.
- 5.2. Series scoring shall be in accordance with US Sailing Appendix A9.
- 5.3. For the Series a DNC is defined as not registering for a Series Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Series plus one.
- 5.4. Ties will be broken using US SAILING Appendix A. If a tie still exists, the winner shall be the yacht ahead in the final race that the two participating yachts both started.
- 5.5. Throw out races will be incorporated into the series scoring with the following formulas:
 - If 10 races are completed, there will be 1 throw out
 - If 14 races are completed, there will be 2 throw outs
 - If 18 races are completed, there will be 3 throw outs
 - If 22 or more races are sailed, there will be 4 throw outs
- 5.6. Sail number changes must be reported to the Series Chairman and reported to the race committee before the first race each day.
