

2011-2012 SCYC MIDWINTER SERIES

NOVEMBER 19, DECEMBER 17, 2011 AND JANUARY 21, FEBRUARY 18, AND MARCH 17, 2012

1 Rules

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing regardless of whether or not a "Y" flag is flown.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This series is open to any boat holding a valid 2011 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate.
- 2.2 There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker PHRF divisions, a double-handed division and a multi-hull division. PHRF divisions will be assigned at the Competitors meeting on November 19, 2011. Double-handed division shall have exactly two persons on board. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons on board.
- 2.3 At least two boats in a division must be in the starting area for that division to be given a warning signal.
- 2.4 Eligible boats must register online at scyc.org or Regatta Network.
- 2.5 A boat is not entered until Regatta Network confirms the registration and the entry fee are paid online.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Entry fees are payable online through Regatta Network or scyc.org to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Early entries (\$70) are due by 1800 November 18, 2011. Regular entries (\$90) will be accepted at the SCYC Club House between 930 and 1000 hours on November 19, 2011. You must register through Regatta Network, as there is no paper entry form available. Late entries should enter on regatta network, and discuss with the race committee.

4 Schedules

- 4.1 A competitors meeting will be at 1000 hours on November 19, 2011 at the SCYC clubhouse.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1155 hours each race day.
- 4.3 Fifteen races are scheduled. There will be three races scheduled each day.
- 4.4 Three races will constitute a series.
- 4.5 There will be an awards ceremony at the SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.

5 Sailing Instructions

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors meeting or may be posted online at scyc.org.

6 Venue

- 6.1 Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys between Capitola and Natural Bridges, in an area approximately 2.5 miles from the Santa Cruz Small Harbor west jetty.

7 Courses

- 7.1 Courses will be distributed with the sailing instructions.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 Boats entered in classes with three (3) or more entries in the regatta are eligible for prizes and/or the Champion of Champions Regatta. Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority.
