Sailing Instructions

1. Rules. This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 version. PHRF-SD RLC ratings, applied arbitrarily in some cases, and these sailing instructions.
 - 1.1 The course is random leg, as defined by PHRF-SD. Classes 1 and 2 will be scored using PHRF-SD RLC ratings. Class 3 will be scored using Coronado Handicap ratings, as posted in the Blue Book at the front desk, at the CYC Racing website or as obtained from Mr Steve Streiffer, CYC Handicapper.
2. Entry. Entry is free and open to members of all yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by US Sailing.
 - 2.1 Enter **online only** through the racing button at <http://race.coronadoyc.org/>. Entry closes at 0900, January 2, 2012.
 - 2.2 Boats racing with PHRF ratings will be placed in Class 1 or 2 based upon their PHRF RLC rating.
Class 1.....PHRF RLC rating of 113 or less
Class 2.....rating of 114 or greater
 - 2.3 PHRF boats not using spinnaker will be scored using the appropriate offset.
Discussion: PHRF boats will be assumed to be sailing with spinnaker, unless they notify the R/C at check-in otherwise.
3. Notices. Notices will be posted online, and on the CYC Official Notice Board on the porch, and after the R/C boat gets underway, notices will be available at the R/C.
4. Start. Three RRS 26 starts, in the order Class 3, then 2, then Class 1 will be provided, with the first Warning scheduled for 1155. R/C uses GPS time.
5. Course. 13.16 nautical miles: (1) Start vicinity SD28 at R/C boat, (2) A mark to starboard, (3) SD26 to port, (4) SD24 to port, (5) SD34 to starboard, (6) A mark to starboard, (7) SD32 to port, (8) GB1 to port, (9) GB8 to starboard, (10) Diver to starboard, (11) finish.
6. Start, Marks, and Finish.
 - 6.1 The Start is at an R/C boat windward of SD28. Finish in front of CYC between a striped piling at the end of B dock and a floating flag or tetrahedron.
 - 6.2 Diver is large orange tetrahedron located at southwest corner Glorietta Bay, near the Boathouse restaurant.
 - 6.3 SD (n) and GB (n) are San Diego and Glorietta Bay channel buoys.
 - 6.4 "A" Mark is a moored large orange tetrahedron located at 32 40N, 117 09 W.
7. Penalty turns. RRS 44.1 is modified to require a single 360 degree turn to exonerate boats who may have violated a rule of Part 2, RRS.

8. Time limit. The time limit for first boat to finish is 1630.
9. Protests. Simplified. Use of red flag and hail are essential. Inform R/C at first opportunity. Submit written protest form (available at office) within 30 minutes of docking of protesting boat. Be prepared to document. Arbitration ASAP on race day. Formal protest January 4, 1900, boardroom.
10. Scoring. Low point system, RRS A4.
11. Retirement. Boats retiring from a race will be scored the same as last in that race. After you finish, notify R/C ASAP of your desire to retire.
