Notice of Race

2012 5o5 and Hobie Kick-Off Regatta April 14 – 15, 2012

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.
- 1.3. RRS 41.1 will be changed for the so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. RRS 61.1 (a) (2) will be changed to apply to all Hobie classes.
- 1.5. Changes to RRS will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This event is open to the 5o5, Hobie 20, Hobie F18, Hobie 18, Hobie 17, Hobie 16, and Hobie Wave Classes
- 2.2. In Hobie classes, at least one competitor on each boat must be a member of the Hobie Class Association of North America.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may register at online at www.regattanetwork.com or at www.scyc.org

3. Fees

- 3.1. Early entry fee is \$96 for double-handed boats and \$68 for single-handed boats if received prior to 1800 hours April 10, 2012 . Youth skippers under 18 deduct \$20 from the entry fee if received prior to 1800 hours April 10, 2012
- 3.2. Late Entry fee is fee is \$116 for double-handed boats and \$88 for single-handed boats if received after 1800 hours April 10, 2012. Boats may enter onsite by presenting a completed 2012 Kick-Off Regatta Entry Form and paying the late entry fee to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club between 09:00 and 10:55 on April 14, 2012
- 3.3. Entry Fees include taco bar and Social at the SCYC Clubhouse on Saturday Night
- 3.4. Additional Dinners can be purchased for \$18 for Adults and \$6 for Children younger than 12.
- 3.5. All entry fees are nonrefundable.
- 3.6. There will be a nominal Trailer and Vehicle parking charge at Santa Cruz Harbor

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Registration will be April 14, 2011 between 09:00 and 10:55 at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club Regatta Office.
- 4.2. There will be a competitors briefing April 14, 2011 at 11:00 in the boat park.
- 4.3. On April 14th, the scheduled time of the warning signal is 12:55 and there are up to 5 races scheduled.
- 4.4. On April 15th, the scheduled time of the warning signal is 12:55 and there are up to 4 races scheduled. No races will be started after 16:00 on Sunday April 15th.
- 4.5. An awards presentation will follow racing on April 15, 2012.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available no later than 11:30 on April 14, 2012 on the Santa Cruz Yacht Club notice board, at the competitor's meeting and may be posted the club website.

6. Venue

- 6.1. Registration, the competitors briefing, launching, and awards will be held at the Santa Cruz Yacht Club. Figure 1: Driving Directions shows the location of the Santa Cruz Yacht Club.
- 6.2. Racing will be around buoy enclosed courses, between Capitola and Natural Bridges in an area approximately 2.5 miles radius from the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2. When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. Prizes

8.1. The number of prizes to be awarded will be at the discretion of the organizing authority and based on early registration numbers.


