Dear 2012 U.S. Junior Women's Competitor and Parents,

On behalf of the USSJWDC Committee, Lake Minnetonka Sailing School (LMSS) and the Minnetonka Yacht Club, we are thrilled to welcome you to Minneapolis, Minnesota! The sailing school and the yacht club share facilities on Lighthouse Island on beautiful Lake Minnetonka. We have been planning for this event for some time and know you will have a memorable sailing experience during your stay. Below is important information regarding the event.

#### **AIR ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:**

The arrival window for all competitors traveling by air will be Sunday, June 24<sup>th</sup> between **11:00 AM and 3:00 PM.** Departure for all competitors will be on Saturday, June 30th. Departing flights should not be scheduled before **11:00 AM or after 3:00 PM on Saturday**. Competitors may leave after the Awards Dinner with a parent or guardian; however, if they plan on doing so, we must be notified in advance. All boats and trailers must be gone by Saturday, June 30th at 12 noon.

You will receive an email from the championship via Regatta Network with a link to add your travel plans. It is imperative that you enter your arrival and departure details no later than June 1, 2012. You can use this link to update/change your plans at any time prior to this deadline.

After June 1, 2012, you must email any changes to the registrar (see Contact List). Any travel arrangements that deviate from the above guidelines must be requested and approved in advance by the National Chair, Danielle Richards, at <a href="mailto:Danielle.Richards@ussailing.net">Danielle.Richards@ussailing.net</a> by June 1st. No exceptions!

#### **UNACCOMPANIED MINORS:**

If you are considered an "unaccompanied minor" by your airline, you must enter this in your travel details on Regatta Network. Appropriate arrangements must be made in advance with the airline, specifically contact/pick up information. The Transportation Chair will be in contact with you regarding these details once you have entered this status into Regatta Network.



There may be an additional charge for the return flight as an unaccompanied minor. You must have enough cash to pay this fee at check-in for your return flight. Please be prepared.

#### **AIRPORT INFORMATION:**

Ground transportation for arriving competitors will be coordinated <u>only</u> between Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport and Minnetonka Yacht Club. You will need to make your way to the baggage claim area without an escort. All major airlines service Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport. Don't forget to include Minnetonka Yacht Club's name and address on your luggage tag in the event your bags are delayed. See Contact List on the last page. Regatta volunteers will meet you in the baggage claim area of the applicable terminal with a "Jr. Women's Championship" sign and will provide transportation to Minnetonka Yacht Club.

Passenger shuttles will be hired for transportation and you will need \$55 cash to cover the round trip charge. FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY, DO NOT ACCEPT RIDES OR TRANSPORTATION to or from Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport that have not been arranged through the regatta.

#### **TRAVEL QUESTIONS:**

We will be tracking the arrival of each person carefully. If there is a flight delay or problems with your itinerary on arrival day, please call the Transportation Hotline at **612-360-6915** immediately. **Program this number into your cell phone.** 

#### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS:**

You can obtain directions to the Minnetonka Yacht Club on the internet using the address in the Contact List.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

Registration will be at Minnetonka Yacht Club on June 24<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 noon – 5:00p. **No early arrivals.** The Shuttle from the airport will drop you off at the Minnetonka Yacht Club's Carson's Bay parking lot. As the Yacht Club is located on an Island, a pontoon shuttle will be running continuously from Carson's Bay during this time. Once you arrive on Light House Island, the registration team will review that all forms have been correctly submitted. Life jackets will be inspected at registration. You will not be allowed to sail unless you have an approved USCG personal flotation device as outlined in the Notice of Race. Refer to the NOR for the requirements. Your sails and boat may be measured at any point. All equipment and sails must be class legal.

There will be a meal served at the Yacht Club starting a 5:00 PM. Host parents will be meeting sailors at the Carson's Bay Parking Lot Yacht Club at 6:30 PM.



#### **WAIVERS:**

Each competitor must send all of the required waivers (5) to the Registration Chair, Lucy Voltz (see Contact List) by May 15th. The waivers are attached to the end of this letter. If any medical issues change after that date, it is the responsibility of the parent/competitor to notify Lucy Voltz. It is suggested that the competitor bring a copy of her medical insurance card and a list of medications, if any.

#### **HOUSING:**

All competitors will be assigned to a host family for the duration of the event. It is a nice gesture to bring a small item to thank your housing hosts. You are guests at their house so please no special meal requests, wet towels, clothes all over the floor, or the like. The final night of housing will be Friday, June 29<sup>th</sup>.

Competitors will not be informed of the name of the host family until registration. No alternative housing will be permitted and no competitor may stay in her own home, regardless of the proximity of her home to the host club unless the competitor is a local girl, who receives specific permission from the National Chair. See Conditions #5.1 for specific rules.

When you arrive at your host family, phone your parents with the host family's phone number. Please exchange cell phone numbers with your host family as well to facilitate pick-up times. Transportation to and from the Yacht Club will be either by walking or by the host family. **Competitors are NOT permitted to drive at any time during the event.** This is for the safety of all. Competitors are required to attend all events.

#### **MEALS:**

Meals for competitors will be provided throughout the regatta. A hot breakfast will be served at the club, Monday through Friday. Lunches will be buffet style and available during breakfast so the sailors make lunches themselves, Monday through Friday. Dinners will be at Minnetonka Yacht Club on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Monday's dinner will be with the host family. Wednesday's dinner will be at the Cottagewood Store. The Awards Dinner will be at Minnetonka Yacht Club on Friday night. Dinner on arrival day will be provided. While the dress code is casual at the Minnetonka Yacht Club, girls are encouraged to dress in a manner in line with the significance of the event for dinner each night. Dress code for the Awards Dinner is slacks or a skirt or dress. Also, please remember that the weather in Minnesota in June is unpredictable—it can be very hot or very cold and change quickly. Please pack accordingly. In an effort to reduce the amount of plastic water bottle recycling, we will use refillable water bottles. Please plan to bring your own water bottle to use during the event.

#### **PARENTS AND GUESTS**

Parents and guests are responsible for their own housing and meals. only. Parents who wish to attend the Awards Dinner may purchase tickets online for reservations in advance until May 15th. Use the link you received from Regatta Network upon your successful registration. Tickets will be \$30 per guest.

Please refer to section 15 of the Notice of Race entitled "Coaching" for information about contact with competitors.

#### **AWARDS DINNER:**

The Awards Dinner on Friday, June 29th will be a well-attended event. Attendance by the competitors is mandatory and is included in their entry fee. The girls typically dress up for this. Competitors will not be allowed to leave before the Awards Dinner without prior approval of the National Chair and permission will only be granted for extenuating circumstances. The Awards Dinner usually concludes at 9 - 9:30 PM.

### **CHARTER BOAT ASSIGNMENT:**

Charters will be available. If you are interested, please e-mail <u>Lizwalker@ussailing.org</u>.

## **CHARTER BOATS-CANCELLATIONS:**

If at any time the competitor's plans change and she will not be able to attend the Championship, or she no longer needs the charter boat that we have assigned, the competitor must notify <a href="mailto:LizWalker@ussailing.org">LizWalker@ussailing.org</a>. Charter fees will only be refunded if the boat can be chartered by another competitor; otherwise you will be responsible for the charter fee.

Charter boats do not include sails, bridles or trapeze harnesses. You will need to bring your own or make arrangements to have them shipped. Sails should be shipped with return shipping labels. Arrangements are the responsibility of the sailor and not the host nor US Sailing.

#### **COMPETITORS' OWN SAILBOATS:**

Competitors who are bringing their own sailboats should arrive at the Minnetonka Yacht Club's Carson's Bay parking lot after noon and before 5:00PM on Sunday, June 24th. Trailers will be stowed for the week at an off-site location. Directions to the trailer storage will be available at registration. Competitors will be expected to attach the provided hull and sail numbers following registration.

**Launching:** A ramp and crane are available at the Carson's Bay for launching sailboats. Each yacht should have a lifting bridle for crane use. All boats must be power washed prior to launching to diminish the spread of invasive species. You will be instructed at registration how to launch your boat.

#### **CREW CHANGES:**

Occasionally unanticipated situations may make it necessary for teams to change crew. There may not be any substitution for members of the team except as provided below.



- i. Substitution of a team member after the semi-final or acceptance in a championship can be requested for medical reasons or death in the family. Exceptions may be made for unexpected work/ school conflicts. Supporting documentation may be requested.
- ii. All substitutions must be adequately explained by the qualified helmsman and accepted by the Organizing Authority.
- iii. In the event that the substitution is not approved, the next team in line will be accepted.

Competitors that wish to change sailing partners must submit a request in writing stating the reason to Danielle Richards, National Chair at <a href="mailto:Danielle.Richards@ussailng.net">Danielle.Richards@ussailng.net</a>. No changes may be made after June 15<sup>th</sup>. We encourage you to plan well in advance in an effort to retain your original team.

#### **RACING CLINIC:**

There will be a mandatory, two-day clinic that will be held on Monday and Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> and 26th. The clinic is funded by a generous donation from the Clagett Trust. You are required to attend with your boat rigged and ready to sail, with a notebook, pen, and current rule book.

## **PRIVATE COACHES:**

Private coaches are not allowed. This is a Grade 2 coaching event. Please read: http://championships.ussailing.org/Youth/USJrWomensDoublehanded/Support Vessels.htm.

#### **SPECTATOR BOATS:**

It is our intent to provide spectator boats for those wishing to go on the water on race days. There will be no spectator boats on clinic days. Pre-registration is appreciated. Spectators will be required to sign up for a spot at registration. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own lunch and drinks. No alcohol will be allowed on the spectator boats. Please bring your own personal flotation device.

Again, please refer to section 15 of the Notice of Race entitled "Coaching" for the rules regarding contact with competitors. NO PRIVATE SPECTATOR BOATS WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE RACING AREA.

## **SAILING VENUE:**

The racing area will be in Lake Minnetonka, likely right in front of the Yacht Club. In late June, the normal average air temperature is in the low 80s, with lows in the high 50s and the water temperature is in the 70s. The winds can be light and variable to blowing briskly. Bring sailing gear appropriate for the weather in Minnesota that can be very unpredictable at this time of year—it's always better to over pack than to be under prepared.

#### **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

The final form of the Sailing Instructions will be distributed at registration. The Sailing



Instructions may be available in preliminary form on the championship's website prior to the event.

#### **WEATHER/APPROPRIATE GEAR:**

The Excelsior zip code is 55331 for accessing weather information. A detailed weather and local conditions seminar will be given to the competitors during the clinic, and daily weather briefings will be presented and posted on each of the racing days. The air and water temperatures are expected to be warm, but again realize they can fluctuate to extremes from the average. Bring sailing gear appropriate for the weather in Minnesota that can be very unpredictable at this time of year—it's always better to over pack than to be under prepared.

#### **ALCOHOL AND DRUGS:**

Per US Sailing Regulation 10.10.01: The use of alcohol or any illegal drug by a competitor will not be allowed or tolerated during the event. Offenders will be dealt with strictly as stated in the Notice of Race.

#### **CURFEW:**

There will be a 10:00 PM curfew during the event; meaning that ALL competitors must be "home" where they are being housed by 10:00 PM each night. These regulations are in effect from Sunday, June 24<sup>th</sup> through Friday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. There will be no exceptions. We are not trying to make the event less fun; we are very concerned for the competitors' safety.

#### TREATING THE HOST CLUB PROPERLY:

Lake Minnetonka Sailing School and Minnetonka Yacht Clubs have been planning and working on this event for over a year. You can be assured that we have planned the best possible event for you, from the racing, to the meals, the social events and the housing. We take our regatta hosting very seriously, and as our guests please show us that you appreciate the hard work of all of our volunteers. Please be as self-sufficient as possible and help others as needed. We expect that you'll jump in and help without being asked!

#### **LOST ITEMS:**

Mark your belongings in advance! We continually find clothes and equipment that competitors leave around throughout the event. All items with a name clearly on them usually get returned. Take a few minutes with an indelible marker and put your name on everything you will be bringing. Also, clearly paint or otherwise mark your own spars and other personal boat equipment.

#### **PACKING LIST:**

- 1. Personal Flotation Device-Type III or V USCG approved only, no exceptions!
- 2. Sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, towel
- 3. Tools and parts for personally owned boats



- 4. A 26 foot, 3/8 inch diameter, floating towline with a loop in the end of the line that is not to be secured to the boat (required)
- 5. Notebook, pen, current Rule Book
- 6. Personal entertainment (e.g. books, Frisbee, iPod)
- 7. One small burgee from your yacht club or sailing association to trade
- 8. Appropriate attire for ALL dinners MYC is casual but dress appropriately; the Awards Dinner is a dress up affair
- 9. Appropriate sailing gear and clothing
- 10. Trapeze harness
- 11. Re-usable water bottle
- 12. A small thank you gift for your host family
- 13. Sneakers for the daily workout
- 14. \$55 cash for airport shuttle fees
