2011 Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions Invitational

Sunday March 25, 2012

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. RRS 40 will be changed to require competitors wear a personal flotation device while racing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This is an Invitational regatta for boats winning a club series or regatta in the 2010 and 2011 seasons.
- 2.2. A list of invited yachts is attached.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may register at [Regatta Network](#) or by filling out the Entry Form and presenting it to the Santa Cruz Yacht Club before 1030 March 25, 2012.

3. Fees

- 3.1. There are no entry fees for this invitational regatta.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. There will be a competitors briefing March 25, 2012 at 1100 at the SCYC Clubhouse.
- 4.2. There is one race scheduled for March 25, 2012.
- 4.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions, including courses to be sailed, will be available after 1100 on March 25, 2012 at the competitors briefing.

6. Venue

- 6.1. Racing will be around buoy enclosed courses, between Capitola and Natural Bridges.

7. Prizes

- 7.1. The overall winner on corrected time will be designated as the 2011 Cliff McNamara Champion of Champions and will have the boat name affixed to the perpetual trophy.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

- 8.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 8.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law
