The **Organizing Authority** is **South Beach Yacht Club**.

1. Rules, Eligibility and Event Classification

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009 – 2012*, except:
- 1.2. J/120 Fleet Five Class rules will replace the National Association Class Rules.
- 1.3. RRS 40 is changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

2. Eligibility and Entry:

- 2.1. The regatta is open to the J120 Fleet Five of San Francisco Bay and any J111 wishing to participate.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing their application at www.southbeachyachtclub.org

3. Entry fees

- 3.1. Entry fees are as follows: \$90, \$125 if received after June 27, 2011.
- 3.2. Late registration will be held on-site on Saturday, June 30 between 0930 and 1000.

4. Schedule of Races

- 4.1. A Competitors meeting will be held on Saturday, June 30 at 1100 hours in the SBYC Clubhouse.
- 4.2. Racing will be held on Saturday, June 30th and Sunday, July 1st.
- 4.3. The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal is 1300 hours on Saturday and Sunday.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available by Thursday, June 28, 2012 at 1800 hours, on the SBYC Club Website under the Racing Page at www.southbeachyachtclub.org The Sailing Instructions will also be made available at the SBYC Clubhouse at the Competitors Meeting.

6. Venue

- 6.1. The race will be sailed in the South Bay Waters of San Francisco Bay located in the general area east of South Beach Harbor and around Anchorage 9.

7. Courses

7.1. Windward – Leeward Courses will be selected using temporary and/or fixed marks.

8. Scoring

8.1. The Low Point Scoring system of Appendix 'A' will apply.

8.2. The Time on Time Scoring method will be used.

8.3. One completed race will constitute a series.

9. Berthing

9.1. Guest berthing is available at South Beach Harbor at the standard marina guest rates. Confirmed availability only if reserved before June 21st. Please contact the harbormaster directly at (415) 495-4911

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
