2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. The Series is open to junior sailors who do not reach the age of 15 years of age, as of December 31, 2012. To be eligible for the SCYYRA SoCal Series Perpetual Trophy participants must be members of a current SCYYRA organization.
- 2.2. Entries for the 2012-2013 Series must be submitted online at www.scyyra.org/socal. An entry with each individual host club must also be completed for each individual Regatta in accordance with the Notice of Race for each event.
- 2.3. A participant may enter the 2012-2013 Series at the first or second scheduled Regatta but no later than the start of the first race of the last day of the second Regatta. Participants may enter any Regatta after the first two but will not be scored for the Series.
- 2.4. So Cal Series entry fee is \$30.00. This fee includes a series souvenir for each skipper.

3. CLASS MEMBERSHIP

- 3.1. So Cal participants must be USODA members in good standing. Sailors may join/renew at www.usoda.org.

4. RULES

- 4.1. Each Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the SoCal Series Rules as published in the 2012 SCYYRA Handbook (or modified online) the USODA Class Rules, this Notice of Series and Sailing Instructions issued by each Host venue.
- 4.2. In regards to Series Scoring decisions of the jury or protest committee are final.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. The Low Point Scoring System, rule A2, will apply with 20 or more races scheduled. A "Did Not Compete" (DNC) is defined as not registering for a Regatta and shall be scored the number of entries in the Series plus one. A "Did Not Finish" (DNF), "Disqualified" (DSQ) and "Did Not Start" (DNS) will be based on the total number of Series starters in each individual Regatta.
- 5.2. Series scoring shall be based on the official results of each race tabulated only against other Series entrants.
- 5.3. Throwout races will be incorporated into the Series scoring with the following formulas:
 - If 11 – 15 races are completed, there will be 1 throwout.
 - If 16-20 races are completed, there will be 2 throwout.
 - If 21-25 races are completed, there will be 3 throwouts.
 - If 25-30 races are completed, there will be 4 throwouts.
 - If 31-35 races are completed, there will be 5 throwouts.
 - If 36 or more races are completed, there will be 6 throwouts.
- 5.4. Sail number changes in any regatta must be reported to and approved by the Series Chairman (or representative) and reported to the race committee prior to the skippers meeting for that Regatta for those races to be scored in the Series.
