- RULES
  - 1.1 The Organizing Authority and regatta host is the Coconut Grove Sailing Club.
  - 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the US Sailing Prescription except as any of the above may be properly changed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. CLASSES AND ELIGIBILITY
  - 2.1 International Optimist dinghies may enter by completing registration and paying all entry fees.
    - 2.1.1 Classes will include:

- 2.1.2 Opti competitors will be placed in the RWB or Green Fleets based on their sailing experience.
- 2.1.3 Opti competitors shall have been born on or after January 1, 1996
- 2.2 Lasers may enter by completing registration and paying all entry fees.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online prior to Registration with printed copies available at check in.

#### 6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 The racing area will be on Biscayne Bay, near the entrance to Brennan Channel.
- 6.2 The courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Pont Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Up to ten races are scheduled. One race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3 If six or more races are completed, each competitor's worst score will be excluded. If ten races are completed, each competitor's two worst scores will be excluded.

#### 8. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to top Three finishers by class. Additional trophies may be awarded at the discretion of the RC.

#### FACILITIES

- 9.1 Boats may be kept on dollies on the Club lawn.
- 9.2 Parking inside the Club entrance gate is reserved for Club Members. Offsite parking is available on the circle just outside the Club's main gate or at the parking garage next to the Library for a \$6 daily rate (with ticket stamped by CGSC).
- 9.3 Support and Coach boats shall register with CGSC during check in.
