Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING; the 2009-2012 ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA); this Notice of Race and by the Sailing Instructions, all of which supplement or modify the former. In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.

Format: This will be a non-rotational regatta. The boat brought will be the boat sailed in all races. This changes ISSA Rule 7.6(a).

Racing Area/Spectating/Coaching: It is our intent to hold all races adjacent to the Belmont Memorial Pier. All coaching must be done from the pier. There should be excellent spectating from the Pier. In the event that the race course needs to be moved (weather, etc.) coaching access in compliance with ISSA Procedural Rules will be provided by the host.

Parking/Boat Storage: Boat, trailer and parking space will be limited. Please maximize efficiency by loading trailers full (trailer pooling), bring dollies for each boat and car pool as much as possible.

Safety: US Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type 3, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.
