Eligibility & Entry

The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A, Lasers, CFJs and any other class with 4 or more boats. Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form at http://www.regattanetwork.com/html/calendar.html

\$15 Sabots & Lasers\$25 CFJs(\$10 Late Fee will apply to all entries received after 5pm on 9/20/12).

Rules:

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the racing rules of sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the skippers meeting and or the Sailing Instructions.

Costume Contest:

Categories will include (Funniest boy, Funniest girl, Scariest girl, Scariest boy, Most original boy, Most original girl, Silliest boy, Silliest girl, Best coach costume, Best adult sailor in costume). Judging: Will take place by the LIYC Jr. Board and prizes will be awarded at the end of the skippers meeting. Entry: All parties must enter at the costume contest table in order to be eligible to receive a prize.

Sailing Instructions:

Will be provided during check-in the day of the event

Venue:

Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at Genoa West (please contact sailing Director for more information)

Racing: Lido channel and or turning basin

Spector's: The best spot to view racing is on the Lido Isle Yacht Club Dock or the NEW clubhouse. Parking: Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.

Penalty System:

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the racing rules of sailing (RRS) A boat may exonerate herself for breaking a rule of Part 2 by making a 360 turn; this modifies Racing Rule 44

Scoring:

The low point system appendix A of the RRS.

Trophies:

Trophies will be awarded at 1630 or as soon as possible after racing each day.
