**Eligibility:** The regatta is open to any boat. Separate starts are planned for the below. At the

discretion of the Race Committee there may be some starts which will combine classes, depending on the number of entrants. This will be announced prior to the first warning.

PHRF A0/A1 PHRF SB° J30 Alberg 30°

PHRF B/C PHRF N J105 PHRF A2 Club Class° J/35

O - Denotes event does not qualify for CBYRA High Point.

Each class must have a minimum entry of 3 boats to be scored separately. If less than 3 yachts are entered in a class, they will be scored as part of the

PHRF division appropriate to their ratings.

Rendezvous: At 0930 in vicinity of Region 3 Mark A "Hackett's Can" GC-1. Check in required. If wind

and tide conditions warrant, the start may be moved North of the Bay Bridge.

**Radio:** Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

**Start:** Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and nearby orange mark.

Signals: First warning at 1030. Class flags as defined in the 2013 CBYRA Green Book. Intended

starting sequence will be posted by 2400 on Thursday 16 May 2013 on the event notice

board at <a href="http://www.scc1944.org/cbyra.htm">http://www.scc1944.org/cbyra.htm</a>.

Course: Depending on weather conditions, a distance race of 10–30NM around CBYRA Regions 2

& 3 marks passing through one of the middle three spans of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. The course will be announced on VHF 72 and will be designated using placards on the Race Committee Signal Boat at the starting line, showing the Region and the CBYRA letter designations of the marks to be utilized in each Region in order to sail the course.

**Finish:** Between yellow flag on a Race Committee boat and nearby inflatable mark, between the

Magothy River entrance and Region 2 Mark T "Baltimore Light".

Time Limit: Saturday 1600. Any yacht not finishing within 1 hour after the first finisher in its class will

be scored TLE. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

**Protests:** Due in writing at GIYS Boathouse within 3 hours of protesting yacht's finish time. Protests

heard starting 1800 on Monday 20 May 2013 at GIYS Boathouse.

Awards: 1<sup>st</sup>/3, 2<sup>nd</sup>/5, 3<sup>rd</sup>/7 & 4<sup>th</sup>/10+ starters. Awards will be presented at the Saturday post-race party.

Social: The GIYS Commodore will host a Dock Party (cookout & keg) at 1730 on Saturday 18

May 2013 at the GIYS Boathouse for competitors in the SCC–GIYS Spring Regatta and the MRSA Spring Classic and guests. Tickets purchased on line by 10 May are \$20 per person. Tickets purchased after Friday 10 May 2013 are \$25 per person. Free overnight dockage or mooring and tender service for yachts competing in the SCC-GIYS Regatta. Call the GIYS Harbor master on VHF 78A for instructions.
