The Rentor agrees that they will:

- Check the vessel and equipment before departure and report any short-comings
- Operate the vessel in a prudent and seaman-like manner
- Return the vessel and all equipment undamaged
- Report any damages, failures or short-comings upon return
- Understand that they may be liable for loss/damage due to their actions or inactions
- Not operate the vessel between sunset and sunrise
- Not operate the vessel in sustained winds over 20 knots
- Not sail in the designated No-Sail zones
- Not dock the vessel anywhere except the RNSYS
- Not operate the vessel under the influence of alcohol or narcotics
- Pump out interior before & after use
- Replace hatch board and close hatch after use
- Remove personal gear and any garbage from boat
- Stow interior, coil lines and tie tiller upon return

Failure to follow the above guidelines may result in monetary penalties, loss of rental privileges or more. The Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron, its Staff, Executive or designate reserve the right to refuse access to these vessels to any Member at any time for any reason.

Waiver

I understand and accept that the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron (RNSYS) and their officers are not liable for any loss, damage, expense or injury that I or my crew members may suffer as a result of my use of this equipment, due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract or failure on the part of the RNSYS to protect me from the hazards of boating. I accept full responsibility for the care of the equipment and agree to pay for any damages that occur during my use of the vessel and equipment.
