Eligibility: Any class with four (4) or more entries will have a separate start.

Rendezvous: SUNDAY at 1000. In vicinity of Annapolis Area Mark "X".
Race Committee boat will display Code Flag "L".
Check-in with Race Committee boat is required.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee,
including potential changes to the starting sequence.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and nearby mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races) as changed below:

Course: Drop Mark type as listed in the 2013 CBYRA Green Book or Region 3 marks as designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat. PHRF N and Cruising Class may use Region 3 marks at the discretion of the race committee. Look for postponement signal after Alberg 30 start for course change.

Finish: Between lime green flag on Race Committee boat and nearby lime green mark, unless course has been shortened after start.

Time Limit: Sunday 1600. Any yacht not finishing within one hour after the first finisher in their class will be awarded a DNF. This changes RRS 35 and A4.1.

Protests: Due at Annapolis Yacht Club within 3 hours of protesting yacht's finish. Protests heard starting at 1800 on Friday 12 July 2013 at AYC Jr. Sailing Center, Annapolis, MD.

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7 & 4th/10+ starters. Awards presented at the Sunday post-race party.

Social: The Sailing Club of the Chesapeake will host a post-race party for all contestants at 1600 on Sunday 30 June 2013 at the home of Stephen Hiltabidle, 110 Summers Run, Annapolis (off Winchester Road). Directions: Route 50 East to exit 27 (Route 450) toward the Naval Academy. Take the first right on Boulters Way; continue under the Route 50 ramp to Winchester Road. Continue straight ahead on Summers Run, through the white brick gate to 110. Look for the SCC Burgee.
