Trans Harbor Race (Spinnaker #2) Rev Course

SECOND RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES SATURDAY, March 23, 2013 An ASMBYC High Point Event

<u>RULES</u>: This race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. PHRF entrants must hold a current PHRF certificate. Multihulls, Martin 242s, Vipers and other one design classes are invited, at least three entries will constitute a class. Advance registration by mail must be <u>received at KHYC by March 22rd</u>. Registration is also available at regattanetwork.com. There will be a \$20 single race entry fee or \$80 for the entire series.

<u>VENUE:</u> The race area will be per the current KHYC Race Mark Guide and the Del Rey Chart #16 as well as the Sailing Instructions and Course Chart available at regattanetwork.com or at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

<u>DIVISIONS</u>: PHRF class splits, using PHRF Area-B Buoy ratings, are as follows: A (137 or less) - B (138 or higher). This is a PHRF Category 4 event and the RLC ratings will apply for scoring.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: There will be one race of approximately 20.8 nm.

The course will be: S - Fs - mdr SS - mdr DD - G - W - Finish

STARTS: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning for "B" boats will be at 1155. "B" boats will start at 1200. "A" boats' warning will be at 1225, start at 1230. (Note: The Multihulls and One Designs will start in the interval between the "B" start at 1200 and the "A" warning signal at 1225). Boats must sail by the RC boat prior to the 1st warning signal for their class in order to be recognized as a starter.

<u>FINISH:</u> The finish is just inside the harbor entrance between an orange flag on the RC boat and the Redondo Beach East Jetty Light (#2) at the harbor entrance.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Area B2 RLC ratings will apply with TOT scoring for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The Fisherman's (PHRF A) and the Jimmie Morris (PHRF B) perpetual trophies will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards event.

<u>FACILITIES:</u> All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
