- 1. **RULES**: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to Stars owned by members in good standing of an ISCYRA fleet. Sport Boats owned by members of a CBYRA affiliated organizations, the Herring Island Sailing Fleet and those registered for the 2013 St. Michaels Wednesday Night Racing are also eligible. For the purpose of this regatta, sport boats are as defined by PHRF of the Chesapeake except that overall length will be limited to 32 ft (http://www.phrfchesbay.org/SOMD/spboat99.htm).

- **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be provided at Registration. They may be posted at www.milesriveryc.org when available.
- 7. **RACING AREA**: The race area will be the Miles River, or adjacent Eastern Bay.
- **8. SCORING**: The low point scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. One completed race constitutes a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total

of her race scores unless (5) five or more races are completed and then she may exclude her worst score. Sport boats will be scored using their Chesapeake Bay PHRF Ratings. Any sport boat classes with three or more entries will also be scored as one-designs.

- 9. **TROPHIES**: Trophies will be awarded depending on the number of participants in each class. The Star Series winner also will also be awarded the Dr. DAVID OURSLER MEMORIAL TROPHY. The Awards ceremony is scheduled at approximately 3:00 pm on Sunday following the racing.
- 10. **LAUNCHING AND BERTHING**: Hoist launching for boats weighing less than 2,000 lbs and dry storage in the Club field storage area are available.
 - ** Boat wash down/cleaning is permitted in the Club field only. **

11. **SOCIAL**:

- **BREAKFAST:** A continental breakfast will be served Saturday and Sunday and is included in the registration fee.
- **COCKTAIL HOUR:** Hors d'oeuvres and beer specials on Saturday evening sponsored by the Club.
- **DINNER:** On Friday and Saturday nights, regular Club Menu Dinner service will be available from 5:30 to 9:00 pm and Bar service is available until 11:00 pm. All are welcome.
