Start /finish: between the orange flag on the shore and the buoy in the west side of basin in front of CCYC.

CCYC1: is the gate entrance to the Coronado Cays channel between "1" and "2".

Mark "A": is a red flag on a bamboo pole at 32 deg. 40.116'N by 117 deg. 08.858'W

Mark "B": is a red flag on a bamboo pole at 32 deg. 39.30'N by 117 deg. 08.50'W

Mark "C": is a red flag on a bamboo pole at 32 deg. 38.70'N by 117 deg. 08.25'W

Mark "L": is referred to on the chart as "FI G 4s 11ft "A" Priv" at 32 deg. 38.424'N by 117 deg. 07.895'W

BP19: is the Coronado Bridge Pier #19 (Navy side of bridge area)

GB1: is the green entrance buoy to Glorietta Bay near mid span south of Coronado Bay Bridge.

GB8: is a red buoy at the edge of the anchorage in Glorietta Bay.

FM-19 is a large, white concrete Fleet Mooring buoy about five feet high lying directly south of the eastern tip of Harbor Island.
