Organizing Authority: Sarasota Sailing Squadron (SSS)



1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Advertising shall conform to the current ISAF Regulation 20 and Class Rules as applicable.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all multihull sailboats.
- 3.2 A minimum of 5 boats makes a class.
- 3.3 Expected: Stiletto, Corsair, Farrier, Formula, Gulfstream, G-Cat, Hobie, Nacra, Reynolds
 One-Design: F-18, Hobie Wave, Weta, Windrider.
- 3.4 The organizing authority reserves the right to group similar boats together to form one or more open classes.

5. Ratings and Class Rules

- 5.1 Boats sailing must have a valid Onedesign, Portsmouth, Class or PHRF rating.
- 5.2 Rating applications & renewals need to be received by 1700 hrs. October 6th, 2013.

7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions and Courses will be available at Registration.

8. Race Area

Racing will be in Sarasota Bay and in the Gulf of Mexico.

9. Penalty System

For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-turn Penalty.

10. Berthing

for the regatta from October 17th thru 20th at the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

11. Scoring

- 11.1 The scoring for the Stiletto Nationals will be based on an aggregate of races from Friday through Sunday.
- 11.2 The scoring for the complete fleet will be based on an aggregate of races on Saturday and Sunday.
- 11.3 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply, except no race will be excluded. This changes RRS A.2
- 11.4 All scoring will be calculated using the Time on Time scoring method.

12. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants in each class. Based upon registrations received, the Organizing Authority may, in its discretion, offer up to 5 trophies for each class, including Corinthian trophies for boats whose crew does not include boat dealers, sailmakers or others whose primary occupation is in the sailing industry.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
