<u>Rules:</u> This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the USSA Prescriptions and the Sailing Instructions. Rule 82 shall not apply.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to members of SCYA recognized Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations, and to any One Design Fleet which establishes a class of three (3) or more entries. Classes expected: Cal 20, C15, Multihull, Farr 40, Martin 242, Viper 640, Ben 36.7, Open 5.7, Star, J109, Level PHRF. If a minimum of 3 boats is not achieved for any particular class, competitors will automatically be entered into the Portsmouth handicap class (three boat minimum required).

<u>Entries</u>: All entries close at 1000, March 30th at King Harbor Yacht Club. Entries mailed to King Harbor Yacht Club, 280 Yacht Club Way, Redondo Beach, CA 90277 or placed in the office at KHYC must be received by Thursday, March 29th. Registration is also available at regattanetwork.com.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$25.00 if received by KHYC or Regatta Network by Thursday March 29th and \$30.00 thereafter. Checks should be made payable to King Harbor Yacht Club.

<u>Venue &Races:</u> An attachment to the Sailing Instructions will show the location of the racing area and Windward/Leeward courses to be sailed. **Three** races are scheduled.

Starting Order: Established classes and starting order will be posted at the Club by 1000, March 30, 2013. First warning will be 1155.

<u>Sailing Instructions and Courses:</u> Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Desk on the morning of the race and on the KHYC website: www.khyc.org.

Protests: As prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

Penalty System: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. Rule 44.3 does not apply.

Scoring: Appendix A4 Low Point Scoring will be applied. Appendix A2 *No Score will be excluded.*

<u>Facilities:</u> All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.

<u>Trophies:</u> Trophies will be presented at King Harbor Yacht Club on March 30, 2013 as soon as possible after completion of races. A sailors Easter Egg hunt with prizes is planned.
